

Social Workers working with CTGHG

Work individually and as part of a team with clients and families of all ages whose lives have been affected by illness or disability. You provide assessment intervention and advice with regards to adjustment to illness, future planning needs, palliative care, caregiver distress, family conflict, individual psychosocial issues and risk management for abuse and neglect at home, at school and in the community. You will have the autonomy to manage your own caseload to meet the needs of your clients, as well as, giving you the flexibility to schedule your own day.

As a member of the inter-professional team, you may provide supportive counseling, assessing and intervening related to depression, anxiety, and grief, and facilitating linkages with support systems. You will be assisting your client and family to understand care needs and to make decisions regarding finances, and placement. You will play an important role in palliative care by supporting the client, family, and home healthcare team. You may assist paediatric clients by providing psycho-educational, therapeutic, and/or other counseling to assist them with social and emotional issues.
